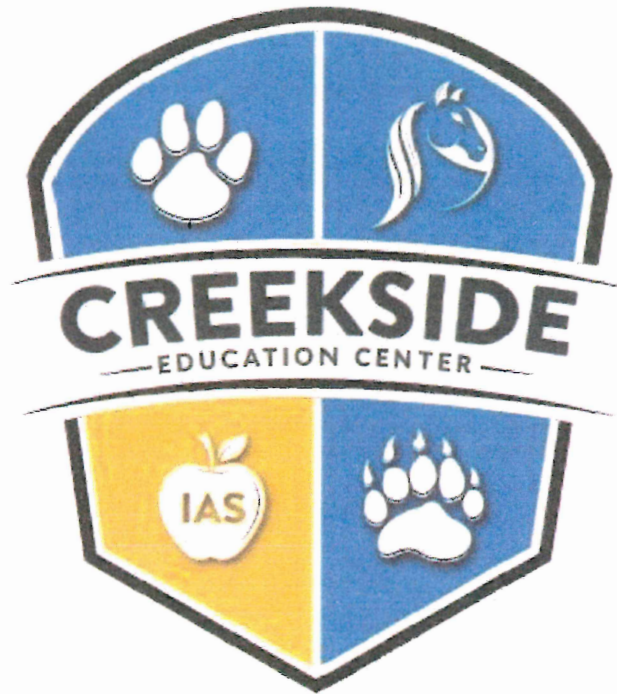

U.S. Citizenship This is a non-credit course designed to prepare non-native speakers of English to become U.S. Citizens. It provides eligible students with the information they will need in order to complete their naturalization applications, learn the U.S. History and Government that is required of new citizens. This course provides citizenship applicants with information on the rights and responsibilities of citizenship, U.S History, Geography and Government, Civics, interviewing skills, English reading, writing, and conversation skills, test taking practice and grammar.

Irvine Adult School Placement Testing & Registration Process

Thank you for your interest in Irvine Adult School. All students will need to complete the following steps in order to register for classes at Irvine Adult School.

Placement Testing Process:

- In order to register for ANY class at Irvine Adult School all students must complete a placement test.
- Students need to bring government issued ID (driver's license, passport, green card) to register and take a placement test
- Assessments are administered on a first come, first serve basis during the time frame listed
- After completing registration and placement testing, each student will be given a randomly generated number to return for registration

Assessment Testing for New Students

January 10th, 11th and 12th
1:30pm – 3:30pm

****For Continuing students, to register in January you MUST have taken the end of semester post-test to register in December.****

- Registration for Continuing Students: January 10th, 11th and 12th at 8:00am to 11:00am
- Registration for New Students: January 16th and 17th at 8:00am to 11:00am
- 150 students will be registered each day based on the Random Number given at placement testing
- You must register for a "CORE" English learner course based on your placement test
- Only students enrolled in the "CORE" English learner course can enroll in the "Conversation Lab" course at the same level based on the placement test.
